

Two-Factor Authentication



Enable MyChart Two-Factor Authentication

Two-factor authentication, also known as 2FA, is an additional level of security on top of a user's password. With 2FA, a one-time code can be sent to a user's email. The user must enter this code before they can log in to view their private heath information.

1. Log into MyChart at mychart.shepherd.org and open the main menu and select Security Settings.



2. On the bottom of the screen, click "turn on two-step verification."

Two-Step Verification Settings

Two-step verification is an additional level of security to help keep your account secure—even if someone has your password.

3. At the pop-up, enter your MyChart credentials again.


